A Shiver of Whale Shark Spotted On The Coast of Nexus Beach

The whale shark, which is regarded as the biggest fish in the world, is frequently on divers' wish lists for ideal dive sightings. These whale sharks live in warm, tropical waters, and we are fortunate to have a migratory season on the west and east coasts of Sabah, Borneo, even though the likelihood of sightings is fairly low.

Whale Sharks are frequent visitors to coast of Nexus Beach in fact annually. It was known that Whale sharks come to feed on the plankton during the cooler months typically between November and February. Most years we have had a handful of Whale Shark sightings during the season while the number of planktons increasing.
